Subject of possible rule making: The Employment Security Department (department), Leave and Care Division, is considering rules for the Long-Term Services and Supports Trust (WA Cares Fund) Program to implement Substitute House Bill (SHB) 2467 (Chapter 120, Laws of 2024) and implement other portions of chapter 50B.04 RCW.
