implements Section 7 of Substitute House Bill 1323, Chapter 112, Laws of 2021, as codified under RCW 50B.04.095. The							

bill, among other things, provides a pathway for federally recognized tribes to elect WA Cares Program coverage. The bill also requires the Employment Security Department to adopt rules to implement the section. Consistent with the elective coverage administrative rules for tribes under the Paid Family and Medical Leave Program, the proposed rule says that any

tribe that opts in to the program is considered an employer as that term is defined under the law, and that the tribe's

employees are considered employees as that term is defined under the law.

<b>Reasons supporting proposal:</b> The proposed rule is necessary to implement portions of the WA Cares Program and provide guidance to federally recognized tribes that may be interested in electing program coverage.
