**Purpose:** Senate Bill 5398 (Laws of 2019, c. 50) amended RCW 50.20.010, RCW 50.20.230, and RCW.50.20.240 and established different eligibility requirements to receive unemployment insurance benefits for individuals complying with an electrical apprenticeship training program. Rules are necessary to more precisely define what these eligibility requirements are and specify the particular electrical apprentices to whom these new eligibility requirements apply.
