



#### REASONS FOR ADOPTING THE RULE

Senate Bill 5398 (Laws of 2019, ch. 50) established different eligibility requirements to receive unemployment insurance benefits for individuals complying with an electrical apprenticeship training program. Rules are necessary to more precisely define what these eligibility requirements are and to specify the particular electrical apprentices to whom these new eligibility requirements apply.

#### VARIANCE BETWEEN PROPOSED RULE AND FINAL RULE

Language in WAC 192-170-010(2) was updated to clarify the definition of allowable apprenticeship programs so it is consistent with the language used throughout the rulemaking.

#### SUMMARY OF COMMENTS TO PROPOSED RULES AND AGENCY RESPONSE
