- Address Change Requirement We are adding an explicit requirement that employers provide their new address to the Department within 30 days after an address change.
 We filed the CR 102 to formally propose the rules. Hearing will be on March 27 at 10:00.
- Space Force We are updating the rule on mandatory military transfers to include all members of the U.S. Armed Forces, including Space Force. We held the hearing on March 6 and are working on formally adopting the rule.
- CRO Filing Working on the CR 101 for a rule amendment to clarify filing requirements with the Commissioner's Review Office.
