Under current rules, petitions for review by the Commissioner's Review Office are considered filed when they are mailed, but replies to petitions for review are considered filed when they are received by the Commissioner's Review Office. This rulemaking specifies that a reply to a petition for review must be filed in accordance with RCW 50.32.025. As a result, a reply must be mailed, rather than received by, the Commissioner's Review Office by the applicable 15-day deadline.
