H-2A litigation & Federal rule changes



- H-2A Litigation (FUJ)
 - ESD regularly communicating with USDOL & following instructions and directives
 - May 2025: Posted prevailing wages on ESD's farmworker page.
 - June 19, 2025: New prevailing wages published. ESD will post updated prevailing wages on its webpage once language reviewed by USDOL.

- Federal rule changes
 - 6/20/25: USDOL WHD announces it is "suspending enforcement of H-2A Worker Protection Rule (2024).
 - 7/2/25: USDOL announces it will amend H-2A Worker Protection Rule (2024) and issues Notice of Proposed Rule-Making (NPRM).
 - ESD plans to provide comments.

Farmworker deaths



- June 29, 2025: near Finley, WA
- July 8, 2025: near Grandview, WA
- Under RCW <<>>, L&I has jurisdiction to investigate work-related deaths
- ESD directs media inquiries to designated L&I Communications contact
- ESD facilitates supportive services, as needed (Mexican consulate, communication with family members, etc.)
- Upon conclusion of investigation, ESD will evaluate findings, if any, of employer non-compliance and evaluate facts for potential Discontinuation of Services




Active contracts & workers












PY25 Active Workers & Contracts by AHO



The Department of Labor **approved** ESD's request to reduce the number of MSFW significant offices from nine to six.


Offices no longer designated as MSFW significant are:

Ag Clearance Order Waiver Update



▶ Re-submitting Clearance Order Waiver to Department of Labor

- The state is resubmitting a request to waive subsection (b)(2) of the Wagner-Peyser Act regulation at 20 CFR 653.501, which states, "(if) the job order for the ES office incorporates offices beyond the local office commuting area, the ES Office must suppress the employer information in order to facilitate the orderly movement of workers within the ES."
- ESD will post for a 15-day public comment prior to formal submission to DOL.
