

Legislative Priorities

Civil Rights such as ensuring Olmstead, ADA, and Section 504 remain intact

Juvenile Justice-Including overcrowding, programming and funding

Homeless advocacy—including Housing First, Access to permanent supportive housing and Funding for wrap around services

Abolishing restraint and isolation of and children with disabilities

Abolish use of solitary confinement for adults with disability

Maintaining funding that allows people with disabilities to live independently in the community

Closing institutions that segregate individuals with developmental disabilities and/or intellectual disabilities

Legalizing psilocybin for use to treat PTS and other mental health disabilities

Substance Use/Alcohol Use disorder services and supports

Language access for Deaf/Late deafened/Hard of Hearing people

Accessible voting for people with disabilities

Digital Equity including infrastructure, digital skills and navigation

Medicaid access and Medicaid services

Protecting people with disabilities in periods of extreme heat

Expanding missing persons alert systems to include an alert for missing people with disabilities

Expanding supported decision making
