The Distressed Areas List for 2010 identifies all counties with three year average unemployment rates equal to or greater than 120 percent of the statewide unemployment rate. Thirteen counties remain on the list, down from nineteen last year. Adams, Clallam, Franklin, Grant, Okanogan, and Yakima have been removed from last year's list. The current list consists of Clark, Columbia, Cowlitz, Ferry, Grays Harbor, Klickitat, Lewis, Mason, Pacific, Pend Oreille, Skamania, Stevens, and Wahkiakum counties.
