which of those emergency rules should be made permanent	
Identify other federal and state agencies that regulate th	is subject and the process coordinating the rule with these
agencies: The U.S. Department of Labor reviews the state's administration of the unemployment insurance program to	
ensure conformity to federal statutes and regulations. The state has broad flexibility in the implementation of the	
unemployment insurance laws so long as conformity is maintained. The proposed regulations will be shared with USDOL	
prior to adoption.
