<b>Purpose:</b> The Employment Security Department is adopting rules to transition emergency rules adopted during the COVID-19 response to permanent rules. The emergency rules cover waiting week requirements, emergency and extended benefits, and standby. Specifically, proposed WAC 192-110-006 waives the one-week waiting period for unemployment insurance benefits when they are fully paid or reimbursed by the federal government. Amended WAC 192-240-070 clarifies what happens if a claimant is paid pandemic unemployment assistance and later is determined to have been eligible for regular unemployment benefits or to have been eligible for pandemic unemployment compensation or extended benefits
