Purpose: Currently, WAC 192-140-035 states that if an unemployment insurance claimant does not respond to a request for information, they are denied benefits "for an indefinite period of time" until they respond to the Department's request for information. This rule amendment will explain the circumstances under which a claimant may requalify for benefits after previously being denied benefits due to failing to respond to a request for information from the Department by formalizing two exceptions to the "indefinite period of time" time frame.
