Centralized leadership from the TAA Program Operator, in collaboration with local office supervision, has created a leaner service delivery model that ensures quick, efficient assistance to TAA case managers, resulting in better customer engagement and service provision. Training plans, data reviews, and payment processes are clarified and approved in less time, reducing wait times. The agency TRA unit leadership provides ongoing training for TRA adjudicators, ensuring they are ready for inquiries from formerly certified TAA workers and program reauthorization.
